**AN ORDINANCE FOR REGULATION OF TRAFFIC
WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP OF HANOVER**

ORDINANCE NO 7

At a regular meeting of the Hanover Township Board held on the 11th day of July, 1979, at 8:00 PM, in the Hanover Township Hall, the following Ordinance was heard and passed:

Be it ordained and enacted by the Township Board of the Township of Hanover, County of Jackson, State of Michigan, as follows:

Code promulgated by the Police Commissioner of the State of Michigan the Township of Hanover hereby adopts by reference the Uniform Traffic for the regulation of traffic within the Township of Hanover.

All violations of provisions of the Uniform Traffic Code are hereby designated to be civil infractions if so designated under Act 300 of the Public Acts of 1949, as amended, said Act being the Michigan Motor Vehicle Code, and shall be processed in the same manner as civil infractions under the vehicle code. Civil infractions are provided for and defined by Act 514 of the Public Acts of 1978, which amends Act 300 of the Public Acts of 1949.

It further is ordained that the Township Clerk is directed and shall keep copies of the Uniform Traffic Code Available at the Township office for inspection by and distribution to the public.

The purpose of this Ordinance is to adopt a code to regulate traffic within the Township, to provide for the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Township.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date allowed by law.

This Ordinance shall be published in the manner provided by law.
