

**HANOVER TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE NO 24  
FIRE AND RESCUE CHARGES**

**SYNOPSIS**

An Ordinance to establish fire and rescue service charges for non-residents of the township for fire protection and rescue service.

**Article I – Name:** Establishes name of the Ordinance.

**Article II – Purpose:** Sets forth the reasons and/or purposes for the establishment of the Ordinance.

**Article III – Charges:** Sets forth who shall be assessed fire and rescue charges. Sets forth how charges are to be established and the mechanisms for establishing the actual fire and rescue charges.

**Article IV – Exemptions:** Sets forth properties and services that shall be exempt from fire and rescue charges.

**Article V – Payments:** Sets forth time for making payments assessed under the Ordinance. Sets forth provisions pertaining to the collection of unpaid charges and the assessment of interest on unpaid charges.

**Article VI – Severability:** Sets forth provision that entire Ordinance is valid and enforceable even if a particular provision is declared void or unenforceable.

**Article VII – Right of Appeal:** Sets forth provision granting Township Board discretion to alter charges based upon specific facts of claim.

**Article VIII – Effective Date:** This Ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days after publication.

This Ordinance was passed on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2004 at a Regular Meeting of the Hanover Township Board.
